
Changes to Offshore Travel Requirements FAQ:

- Do I need to take the BP Offshore Readiness Program e-learning module even though I already have the License to Go Offshore (LTGO) certification?
 - **No. Individuals who have previously completed LTGO will not have to complete the Offshore Readiness Module.**
 - Who is required to take the BP Offshore Readiness Program?
 - **Personnel flying to platforms AND rigs, with the exception of some vessels, must take the program. If you travel to either a platform or rig, you are required to take the Offshore Readiness Program prior to travel.**
 - The current Offshore Travel Requirements shows that the e-learning module is optional for vessels and rigs. Is this true?
 - **No. This was a mistake that will be corrected soon. Rigs are required to take the e-learning module. The module is optional only for GPO vessels.**
 - Is there an expiration date for the BP Offshore Readiness Program e-learning module?
 - **No. This certification does not expire, nor is there a refresher for the course.**
 - Do I need to take the BP Offshore Readiness Program e-learning module *before* I travel offshore?
 - **Yes. You must have taken this course and submitted the certification for credit at least two weeks prior to traveling offshore.**
 - Can I take the site-specific module before traveling offshore?
 - **No. The site-specific module will be taken when the passenger is on the asset.**
 - What browser do I need to access the e-learning module?
 - **Internet Explorer (version 8 or higher). Utilizing Firefox, Safari, etc. may give you an error message.**
 - What should I do if the link to the video does not work?
 1. Go to **Start -> All Programs -> Windows Media Player**
 2. Press **Ctrl + U**
 3. Paste the following URL in the **Open URL dialog box**:

 - How do I get credit for taking the e-learning module?
 - **Individual:** Print, sign/date, scan, and submit the last page of the module. Send the page to Teleios@bp.com with "**TRAINING CERTIFICATION VALIDATION**" at the start of the subject line. Provide the GS number, name and DOB of the passenger in the body of the email. If you do not know your GS number, contact Teleios@bp.com.
 - **Group:** Create a roster / sign in sheet on company letterhead with the following information: GS number, name, DOB of the passenger. Send the page to Teleios@bp.com with "**TRAINING CERTIFICATION VALIDATION**" at the start of the subject line.

- If I take the course in a Group setting, should I also submit the last page of the module for credit?
 - **No. If your employer submits the roster, this is sufficient. Please do not submit a completion certificate if your employer has already submitted the roster.**
 - What should I do if I do not know the GS number?
 - **Please contact Teleios@bp.com who will provide you with the information.**
 - Will the e-learning module be tracked in iLogistics similar to LTGO?
 - **Yes. iLogistics will record that you have taken the module once we receive proof of completion.**
